### What can go in?

Clean, dry paper or cardboard products.



### Attention!

Wet or dirty paper cannot be reused and belongs with non-recyclable waste.



VFG

### What can go in?

Vegetable, Fruit & Garden waste plus food leftovers.



### Attention!

Fish and meat remains can also go in this container.



PMD

### What can go in?

Empty Plastic and Metal packaging and Drink cartons.



### Attention!

Is the waste plastic or metal, but not packaging? Toys, nappies and polystyrene, for example, don't belong with PMD. Take them to a recycling centre or put them in with the non-recyclable waste.



clothing & textiles

### What can go in?

Dry clothing and textiles.



### Attention!

Tie pairs of shoes together. Put textiles into a closed bag to keep them dry.



glass

### What can go in?

Glass packaging including lids.



### Attention!

Oven- en microwave trays, vases and plate glass do not go in the glass container. They should instead be taken to the recycling centre.



non-recyclable waste

### What can go in?

Waste which can not be recycled.



### Attention!

Only properly separated waste can be used as raw materials for new products. Do you have (a bag of) waste which is not separated? Then put this in the container for non-recyclable waste.

### Clothing and textiles

Your textiles can make others happy. If your clothing or textiles are torn, they can still be used as stuffing for chairs or thread for new clothing.



### VFG

Vegetable, Fruit and Garden waste can be used to make compost or fuel for burning.



### Paper

Old paper and cardboard can be used to make new paper for such things as newspapers, printer paper and magazines.



### PMD

All kinds of new products can be made from collected PMD, from new bottles and other packaging to car parts, buckets and crates.



### Glass

Glass can be endlessly recycled. If everyone put their glass into the recycling container, new raw glass would never have to be made again..



### Non-recyclable waste

Nothing. If you were to separate all the raw materials, there would be almost no waste left over. There are often raw materials in the non-recyclable waste, which is incinerated.
